* FLASH FLOOD WARNING FOR... DAVIDSON COUNTY IN CENTRAL NORTH CAROLINA... WESTERN MONTGOMERY COUNTY IN CENTRAL NORTH CAROLINA... RANDOLPH COUNTY IN CENTRAL NORTH CAROLINA... EASTERN STANLY COUNTY IN CENTRAL NORTH CAROLINA...

* AT 350 PM EDT, DOPPLER RADAR INDICATED TRAINING THUNDERSTORMS THAT WERE CONTINUOUSLY REDEVELOPING ACROSS THE WARNED AREA. UP TO TWO INCHES OF RAIN HAVE ALREADY FALLEN. FLASH FLOODING IS EXPECTED TO BEGIN SHORTLY. WE HAVE ALREADY RECEIVED REPORTS OF STREET FLOODING IN ASHEBORO.

* SOME LOCATIONS THAT WILL EXPERIENCE FLOODING INCLUDE... HIGH POINT, ASHEBORO, LEXINGTON, ALBEMARLE, RANDLEMAN, TROY, BADIN LAKE, NORTH CAROLINA ZOO, THOMASVILLE AND SEAGROVE.

PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...

EXCESSIVE RUNOFF FROM HEAVY RAINFALL WILL CAUSE FLOODING OF SMALL CREEKS AND STREAMS, URBAN AREAS, HIGHWAYS, STREETS AND UNDERPASSES AS WELL AS OTHER DRAINAGE AREAS AND LOW LYING SPOTS. DO NOT DRIVE YOUR VEHICLE INTO AREAS WHERE WATER COVERS THE ROAD. MANY ROADS AND INTERSECTIONS IN THE AREA WILL QUICKLY FLOOD. WHEN ENCOUNTERING FLOODED ROADS, TURN AROUND, DON'T DROWN
