* WHAT...FREEZING RAIN EXPECTED. THE THIN GLAZE WILL RESULT IN VERY SLIPPERY CONDITIONS ON SIDEWALKS, ROADS AND BRIDGES, ESPECIALLY DURING THE EVENING COMMUTE ON MONDAY. TOTAL ICE ACCUMULATIONS OF A LIGHT GLAZE ARE EXPECTED.

* WHERE...FORSYTH, GUILFORD AND DAVIDSON COUNTIES.

* WHEN...FROM NOON MONDAY TO MIDNIGHT EST MONDAY NIGHT.

* ADDITIONAL DETAILS...WHILE SPOTTY LIGHT FREEZING RAIN OR SLEET MAY OCCUR AROUND MID DAY, THE HIGHEST PRECIPITATION CHANCES WILL BE FROM MID AFTERNOON THROUGH EARLY EVENING. WHILE PRECIPITATION AMOUNTS ARE EXPECTED TO BE VERY LIGHT, GENERALLY JUST A FEW HUNDREDTHS, THIS LITTLE AMOUNT WILL QUICKLY FREEZE ON IMPACT DUE TO OUR RECENT COLD SPELL. THUS, ONCE PRECIPITATION STARTS AT YOUR LOCATION, ROAD CONDITIONS ARE EXPECTED TO RAPIDLY DETERIORATE.

PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...
